## Motion

## Finance Report-was reviewed by the Board (attachment on file)

Kelly Sweeney informed the Board that:

- Last meeting Kelly reported that Watervliet had not paid what was owed thus far this year. Since then we have received a payment of $\$ 107,000$ from Watervliet.
- last meeting we were also informed that Schenectady's payment was pending as well but as of today they are paid up to date.
- Billing \#6 is coming up. We still have and outstanding balance of $\$ 190,000$, but we are confident that we will receive the monies owed.
- State and Federal Lunch receivables has had a lag this year but is expected to come through.
- We have received a \$60,000 donation to the Internship Program from Charles Touhey. Mr. Touhey has also donated \$24,000 towards the senior's International trip to Dominican Republic.
- The last time that students were to go to the Dominican Republic the pandemic hit and everything was shut down. Jet Blue Airlines at that time could not give us a refund but they were able to give us a credit of $\$ 10,000$ which is being applied to the trip for this year.

Principal's Report-was reviewed by the Board (attachment on file)
Dr. Haig informed the Board:

- We have hired several first year teachers. Dr. Lowe and I met to work on restructuring our coaching model. We integrated a schedule for coaching and intensified it to support teachers.
- I worked with the Instructional Team on modifying coaching sessions for three middle school teachers. I met with the Data team on Edulastic data reports, Quarter 2 failures and action items to support teachers on reteaching strategies and instructional delivery.
- Due to EIA and Math scores are we will be giving our students a practice test to see where they are at and how to better prepare them.
- We held a zoom community meeting on March 8. During the meeting we discussed how Federal grants were spent at Green Tech, Traffic Safety, and Parent University Sessions.
- I met with Paul Madelene to discuss the fund raising campaign for the upcoming school; we are considering specific financial target goals.
